Psalm 41; John 13; Matthew 26:14-16; Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Mark 12:30-31; Matthew 5:43-48

Discussion Guide

ENGAGE

- 1. Share about a time when you were "taken advantage of," when someone used relationship to get something from you.
- 2. What effect did this event have on your relationship? Did this event cause harm or strengthen?
- **3.** Read John 13:2;13-20. Who were the people gathered with Jesus? What do these verses reveal about Judas? Weigh your own emotions toward Judas—do you feel angry, betrayed, compassion?
- 4. Considering v.14-15, what "Jesus-example" can we emulate knowing that He washed Judas' feet?
- 5. How does serving with no expectations strengthen your faith?

APPLY

Practice listening prayer. In prayer ask two questions: 1. Who can I serve? 2. How can I serve? After each question be quiet for 1 minute and listen (expect impressions, pictures, words) for the who and how of each question. On a piece of paper or in your journal, write down what you "hear" in your time of listening. Save this and be ready to reframe transaction and serve love in action.
