# **Message Notes**

- 3 Common ways we settle for find our identity in the approval of others:
  - 1. Acceptance "You'll only be accepted if you pretend to be like them"
  - 2. Performance "Earn their approval by showing them what you can produce"
  - 3. People-Pleasing "They will only like you if you say yes to everything they ask"

# **ENGAGE**

- 1. Share the last things you listened to in your car and why you were listening to that.
- Read Ephesians 6:17-18. How do "Salvation", "Spirit", "Word of God", and "Praying in the Spirit" relate to 2. your identity as a Jesus follower?
  - How can you tell the difference between living for the approval of people and living from the approval of God?
- How does it make you feel that you are fully known by God? How can that help you have real conversations with Him rather than trying to pretend with Him?
- "You are not my enemy." "Comparison is a liar." "Live with peace." "I am known." Which of these four statements has been most helpful for you in fighting against the lies of the enemy and standing firm in your identity in Christ?
