ENGAGE

- **1.** There are many studies that reveal the role birth-order plays in personality. How do you see your own birth-order (oldest, middle, youngest) reflect in your personality?
- **2.** Read Colossians 1:15-17. How do you understand the phrase "image of the invisible?" Historically, what are the benefits of being "firstborn?" According to this passage, what role did Jesus play in creation?
- **3.** Read Colossians 1:18-20. How do you understand that Jesus is the "head" of the church? In vs.20 what does the word reconcile mean? How did Jesus make "peace?"
- **4.** Why do you think it was challenging for Colossians to recognize the supremacy (v.18) of Jesus? What circumstances can make this challenging in your own life?
- 5. Share about a time when you placed your trust in someone or something other than Jesus.

APPLY

• On a notecard or small loose piece of paper, make a list of the people, things, and circumstances you have put ahead of Jesus in your life. Turn it over, on the new front-side, write "JESUS FIRST." The prayer pattern with which I am most familiar typically begins with thanksgiving, petitions, and praises and concludes with: "in Jesus' name, Amen." As you close your time with this material in prayer, begin in Jesus' name and allow your prayer to flow from JESUS FIRST.
