ENGAGE

- **1.** Share about an important relationship in your life. How do you stay connected? What were the circumstances around the most significant growth in closeness in this relationship?
- **2.** Read Colossians 4:2-6. What is Paul asking from the Colossians? With what intentions does Paul instruct the Colossians to have in their approach to prayer? (v.2)
- **3.** For what is Paul asking for prayer? How does the prayer of the Colossians prepare him for his ministry? (v.3-4)
- 4. What is the encouragement that Paul gives the Colossians in verses five and six?
- **5.** This encouragement and call to Prayer was for the church in Colossae. How can these instructions guide us as we pray for our church?

Commit to praying for your church every day from today to Easter. Begin your prayer with both a watchful (careful) and grateful attitude. Pray for an opportunity to share the Good News of Jesus by invitation to Easter. Pray that you would know uncommon boldness and limitless grace. AMEN.
