ENGAGE

1. Share about something or someone you invested in and saw a good return on that investment.
2. Read 2 Timothy 1:3-8 imagining you are Timothy, and this was written to you. What specific things is Paul encouraging and celebrating in you? How do Paul's words make you feel?
3. Read 2 Timothy 1:3-8 again, this time imagining you are Paul writing these words. Why are you encouraging and celebrating these specific things? How does sharing these words with Timothy make you feel?
4. Thinking about your own life right now, answer the questions from this Sunday's message:
 - Who are you all-in on investing into?
 - What kinds of investments are you making?
 - What God-sized return are you inviting them into?
 - How are you multiplying the investments made in you?

APPLY

- Prayerfully consider how you might be an even greater return on the investments made into you this week. What has the Lord shown you to be a strength of yours? Intentionally use that strength this week. What piece of scripture has been sticking out to you lately?
