- 1. Share about an event in your life that had a lasting effect.
- **2.** Read John 11:17-26. Into what situation did Jesus walk? What was Martha's concern? What did Martha believe about the resurrection before this conversation with Jesus?
- **3.** How does Jesus expand Martha's understanding of resurrection in verses 25-26? How does this expanded understanding of resurrection impact the life of a faith-filled follower of Jesus?
- **4.** For Mary and Martha, the power of resurrection brought life back to their brother Lazarus. For what in your life would you like to see the power of resurrection at work?

APPLY

In two different statements, Jesus hopes for the healing and resurrection of Lazarus to inspire belief. How is the resurrection power of Jesus working in your life inspiring belief in the lives of others? Share the answer to this question with one person this week . . . tell your story.
