### ENGAGE

3. What do you imagine Jesus meant when he referenced the "Kingdom of God," in verse 27?
4. In verse 31, Elijah and Moses spoke to Jesus about his departure. What is this departure of which they were speaking?
5. How is your understanding and experience of the Kingdom of God shaped by this moment witnessed by Peter, John, and James?
