## **Discussion Guide**

### **ENGAGE**

- 1. Share about a time when frustration pushed you beyond your ability to practice self-control.
- **2.** When you consider your frustrations, what can you observe about the circumstances that are particularly frustrating.
- **3.** Read Numbers 20:6-12. What were the instructions God gave to Moses and Aaron? (v.8) How did Moses and Aaron follow those instructions? (v.8-11) What were the differences?
- **4.** What was the consequence for a lack of trust? For the Israelites? For Moses and Aaron?
- **5.** What practices help you to adjust your attitude in times of frustration and keep your trust where it belongs . . . in God?
