## Scripture

Matthew 6:19-34; Matthew 6:5-15; Mark 10:17-31

### Discussion Guide

#### ENGAGE

- 1 Share about a time in your life when you experienced scarcity or abundance in the area of finances. How did/do you see God in the middle of your experience?
- 2 Read Matthew 6:21. Put this verse into your own words. How do you see the challenge of this verse play out in your life?
- **3** Read Matthew 6:27. Put this verse into your own words. How do finances lead to worry for you?
- **4** Read Matthew 6:33. Put this verse into your own words. What is the Kingdom of God? How does this verse speak to priorities in your life?
- **5** Describe how trusting God more in the area of finance would impact how you think and act.

### **APPLY**

In your growth group or for yourself, identify the area within finances that is causing you the greatest anxiety. Through prayer, invite God to show Himself in the middle of what you are going through—where do you see God today? Write a trust statement (i.e. I trust God with my child's college tuition, I trust God with my rent) on a Post-it that you can place somewhere that you see daily as you build a daily practice of trusting God with your finances. Note: this practice is a first step, so know that you will grow into trust as you practice trust.

#### PRAY

Dear Lord, I (we) confess that I have room to grow in trusting you. Show me (us) where you are and be with me (us) as I (we) practice daily trusting You more. **AMEN.**
